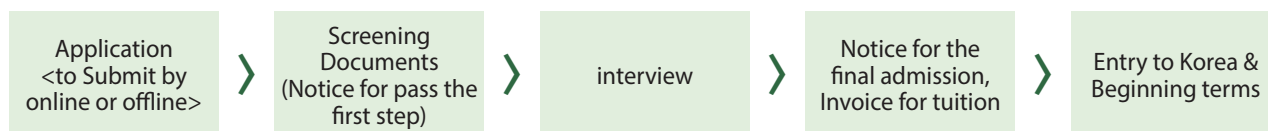

○ Entrance Requirements

A high school diploma or the equivalent qualification is the minimum requirement

○ Procedure of Admission



○ Application Process

- ▶ Required documents
 - A completed application form (KLI format)-2 copies of photo
 - A photocopy of the passport and a photocopy of the Alien Registration Card (if you have one).
 - A copy of diploma or degree from the last school attended (Certified by the Ministry of Education or Apostille document needed)
 - A Certificate of bank deposit balance over \$10,000(USD) under student's name
 - A Personal statement and a Statement of Purpose
 - A copy of a Proof of Foreign Student Insurance (If you have not registered during the time of application, you need to register one in Korea)
 - A Financial Statement of a Korean Sponsor (KLI format)
 - Limited to applicants who have individually applied at KLI.
 - Qualification: Korean who own real estate in Korea and pays monthly income tax of 150,000 won.
 - Period of sponsorship: 3 years after the date written on the form
 - Required document: an original certified copy of the resister, an original withholding receipt, an original proof of employment
 - Notarization: When the student is accepted after the document review, he/she needs to submit a notarized copy of financial statement and personal reference.
- ▶ PLEASE NOTE
 - Depending on Nationalities or financial status, additional documents may be requested.
 - The original documents must be submitted before the interview.

○ Application fee and Tuition

- ▶ Application fee: 100,000 Won
- ▶ Screening fee: 50,000 Won *It may vary by nationality.
- ▶ Tuition: 1,800,000 Won(1 term, 200hrs) *Tuition may change on every March
- ▶ Payment Procedure
 - Notice of Admission: The KLI will inform the student who have been accepted of admission after the screening process.
 - Payment
 - The invoice will be given for the students get the admissions after screening the application.

○ Refund

- ▶ Application
 - Documents : A copy of Refund Application form (KLI format) and a copy of bank book needs to be submitted.
 - Eligibility: Third-person can not apply on the behalf of the student. Only when the student is not in Korea and have written an official letter of delegation, the third-person can apply.
- ▶ Withdrawal
 - Refund amount: in accordance with the KLI's Regulations (notified on the Homepage)
 - Students who want to cancel the enrollment after obtaining visa must request the department to cancel their visa.

○ Placement Test

- ▶ Eligibility: Only newly entering students can take the test.
- ▶ Tests: Reading, Writing, Speaking test.
- ▶ Please note : If you don't take placement test, you will automatically be placed in level 1 (Basic) class.

○ Classes

- ▶ Class Hours
 - 4 terms a year (Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter), 10 weeks per term.
 - 5 days a week (Mon.~ Fri.), 4 hours/day (09:00~13:00, 13:30~17:30)
 - *Only new Registrants could be in afternoon class depending on circumstances.
- ▶ Levels : Level 1~Level 2(Elementary), Level 3~Level 4(Intermediate), Level 5~Level 6(Advanced)
- ▶ Classes are taught in teams of a homeroom teacher and a sub-homeroom teacher.

○ Major activities and events

- ▶ Curricular activities: Each term, students will have the opportunity to experience Korean cultural activities that are appeared in the textbook.
- ▶ Extra-curricular activities: After school leisure or cultural activities (optional)
- ▶ Events
 - Field Trip
 - Spring term and Fall term (a night and two days trip): Cultural experience and also to build rapport with classmates
- ▶ Summer/Winter term: Essay Contest, Presentation, Bazaar, or Video Contest, etc. (selectively by the term)

○ Advancement

- ▶ condition: attendance rate should be higher than 80% and exam scores on average should be higher than 70 (out of 100)
- ▶ Attendance: 3 tardies are considered as 1 absence.
- ▶ Please note: If your attendance rate is lower than 80% without any particular excuses, your visa extension will be denied.

○ Please Note

- ▶ When a student fails three times in Korean language program and breaks rules and regulations in dormitory, he/she will be forced to leave the country.
 - *Rules and Regulations of dormitory, ex) smoking in the dormitory, drinking and cooking, breaking the curfews, etc.



○ Entrance requirements

There are no particular academic requirements or nationality restrictions to apply.

○ Application Procedure

- ▶ Required Documents
 - Application form (KLI format)- 2 photos
 - A copy of Passport and a copy of Alien Registration Card (if you have one)
- ▶ Please note: Additional documents could be requested, depending on nationalities and financial status.
This course does not provide a VISA.

○ Application fee and Tuition

- ▶ Application Fee: 50,000 won.
- ▶ Tuition: Please check the table below
- ▶ Procedure for payment: After the screening, KLI will inform the student of acceptance to the program.
- ▶ Please note
 - Payment must be made under the student's name.
 - Receipt of transfer may be requested, on demands.

○ Refund

- ▶ Application
 - Document: A completed Refund Application form (KLI format) and a copy of bank book needs to be submitted.
 - Eligibility: Only the students who will get refunded must apply. Third-person cannot apply for the students. Only when the student is not in Korea and have written an official letter of delegation, the third-person can apply.
- ▶ Refund
 - 10 days before the term begins: All refund – tuition and Dormitory fee (except admission fee)
 - 9 days ~ 1 day before the term begins: All refund – tuition (except admission fee)
 - After the term begins: No refund.

○ Placement Test

- ▶ Dates: The placement test will be held on the first day of class.
- ▶ Tests: Reading, Writing and Speaking.
- ▶ Please note: If you don't take placement test, you will be placed automatically in the level 1(elementary) class.

○ Classes

- ▶ Levels: Level 1~Level 2(Elementary), Level 3~Level 4(Intermediate), Level 5~ Level 6(Advanced)
- ▶ Each class is team-taught by a homeroom teacher and a sub-homeroom teacher.

○ Cultural Activities

- ▶ Extra-curricular activities: After school activities experiencing Korean traditional culture or popular culture.

○ Field Trip

- ▶ All day experience class: Heightening motivation to learn Korean language by experiencing Korean culture and promote friendship with classmates.

○ Eligibility

- ▶ A high school diploma or the equivalent qualification is the minimum requirement
- ▶ Those whose first language is not Korean should be TOPIK level 5 or above.
Students who have completed Level 5 or higher of Korean Language Education at Konkuk University Language Institute (Seoul) or other Universities.

○ Target of Support

- ▶ A person who teaches Korean to a person whose native language is not Korean
- ▶ Teachers for the children of Multicultural Families and Volunteers overseas
- ▶ Those who prepare for the Korean Language Teacher Certificate Level 3
- ▶ Those who prepare Korean language Teaching at the University, elementary or secondary educational institutions in domestic or overseas

○ Privilege

- ▶ Certificate of Completion of the President of Konkuk University
- ▶ Eligible to take the Korean Language Teachers Level 3 Exam

○ Registration procedure

- ▶ Required documents
 - an Application (KLI form)
 - Foreigners: A copy of passport and alien registration card (only for holders)
 - Please submit the application with other required documents within the period by email or visiting the KLI administration office.

○ Registration procedure

- ▶ Application fee: 50,000 won
- ▶ Tuition: 950,000 won (included textbooks cost and training fee)
- ▶ Payment process: Notice from KLI after passing examination of documents

- ▶ This program does not provide a visa.
- ▶ Foreigners only who are qualified as TOPIK level 6 can take the Korean teachers Level 3 test.

Admission for International Students

○ Qualification

▶ General Admissions (Freshmen)

1) Applicant as a graduate of high school who has completed the formal curriculum equivalent to Korean elementary and secondary education in a foreign country and a person whose parents are not Korean nationals

2) Transfer Admissions (3rd Year)

- Applicant must have met all the requirements for general admissions and meet under one of the following two conditions.
 - Applicant must have completed or be expected to complete at least 2 years of a 4-year undergraduate degree program -with acquisition of 1/2 of all required credits for graduation-at an accredited university in Korea or abroad with good academic standing.
 - Applicant must have graduated or be expected to graduate from a 2- or 3-year associate degree program at an accredited college in Korea or abroad with good academic standing.

▶ Requirements for the Language Proficiency (both for New/Transfer): Those who meet one or more of the following language qualifications

- TOPIK Score Report with Level 3 and above
- Korean Language Program Completion Certificate with Level 3 and above issued by KU Language Institute
 - ※ In the case you apply for KU and get the admission without obtaining a Grade 4 or higher level of Korean Language Proficiency Test (TOPIK), you must obtain a Grade 4 or higher Korean Language Proficiency Test (TOPIK) before graduation.

▶ Note

- Applicants completed from the following courses are not eligible for admissions: university preparatory courses, continuing education courses, adult university courses, correspondence courses, internet courses, high school diploma equivalency exams in the U.S. and Canada (like GED), and the Higher Education Self-taught Examination System of China (gaodengjiaoyu zixuekaoshi)
- Applicant with dual citizenships including Korean nationality is unqualified and cannot apply for Konkuk University Undergraduate Program. If a person or parent loses his or her Korean nationality, he or she will submit a separate document to prove the loss of his or her Korean nationality.

- ※ Some departments of engineering operate programs in accordance with the ABEEK standard. (Majors: Civil & Environmental Engineering, Mechanical & Aerospace Engineering, Electronic & Electrical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Industrial Engineering)
- ※ Transfer students may not be able to graduate within 4 semesters due to the issue of completion of Korean language course.
- ※ Multi-degree degrees can only be applied to students from native schools who have entered into Multi-degree agreements with the university and specific support departments are subject to bilateral agreements.
- ※ The four departments of the College of Education select only a few people in accordance with the Regulations on the Off-Site Operation of the Ministry of Education.
- ※ Applicants are required to select and apply for three departments as required. However, some departments (Media & Communication, Digital Culture & Contents, Business Administration, Cosmetic Engineering, College of Art and Design, and College of Education), which focus on supporting international students, can be selected and supported with only one choice.

○ Eligibility

- ▶ A person who has completed all levels of education equivalent to elementary, junior high, high school, and undergraduate school in a foreign country.
- ▶ Applicant and his/her parents should be both foreign nationals.
- ▶ Language Proficiency (The applicants must meet one of the following language proficiency requirements.)
 - TOPIK(Korean Proficiency Test) level 3 or higher.
 - Korean Language Program Completion Certificate with Level 3 and above issued by KU Language Institute
 - A certain level of official test of English language proficiency (required) (minimum of TOEFL PBT 550, CBT 210, iBT 80 / IELTS 5.5 / TEPS 550)
- ▶ If the student can speak only English and no Korean, he/she must consult with the department before the application is processed to see whether the department will accept the application or not.
- ▶ Korean Language and Literature is for the applicants with higher than level 5 (Korean Language)
- ▶ MA Program
 - A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in and out of Korea (including candidates expected to receive a bachelor's degree either in February or in August)
 - Educational attainment equivalent to a bachelor's degree approved by the law of the country of residence.
 - Limitations
 - Department of Biomedical Science & Technology: Only a bachelor's degree holder in Medicine, Pharmacy, Veterinary Medicine, Biological Science, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Engineering can apply.
- ▶ PhD Program
 - A master's degree from an accredited college or university in and out of Korea (including a candidate expected to receive a master's degree either in February or in August)
 - Limitations
 - Department of Biomedical Science & Technology: Only a master's degree holder in Medicine, Pharmacy, Veterinary Medicine, Biological Science, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Engineering can apply.
 - Department of Advanced Technology Fusion: Only a master's degree holder in Natural Science, Engineering, Agriculture, Medicine or Pharmacy can apply.

- ▶ Application for new international students will be conducted through document evaluation, and interviews will be conducted in the case of Art or physical education majors.

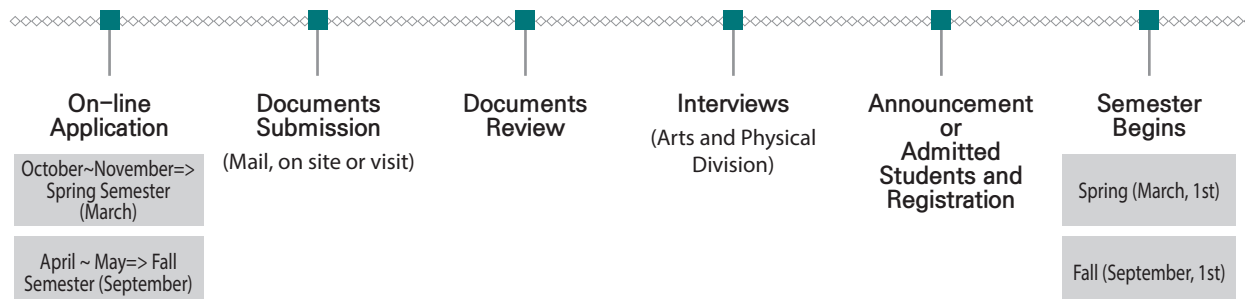
- ▶ Information for the Arts & Physical Division applicants
 - Department of Music: Performance Assessment will be conducted.
 - Department of Design (Submit on the day of interview)
 - MA Program: Portfolio Submission
 - Ph.D Program: Portfolio, Research Plan, MA Degree Thesis should be submitted.
 - Department of Living Design (Submit on the day of interview)
 - Portfolio Submission- 15 or more photographs or a CD file
 - Research Plan – A4 sized 1~2 pgs.
 - No interview for foreign residents, but it can be done by telephone interview if necessary.
 - Department of Contemporary Art (Submit on the day of interview)
 - Bring Portfolio- 10 pieces of work based on his/her interest in the major.
 - Painting: A4 size photographic reduction (title, medium, size, the date of completion for each work should be stated)
 - Sculpture & Installation: A4 size photographic reduction (title, medium, size, the date of completion for each work should be stated)
 - Media Art: A4 size images (in case of moving images, it should be submitted in a CD of a video format file)

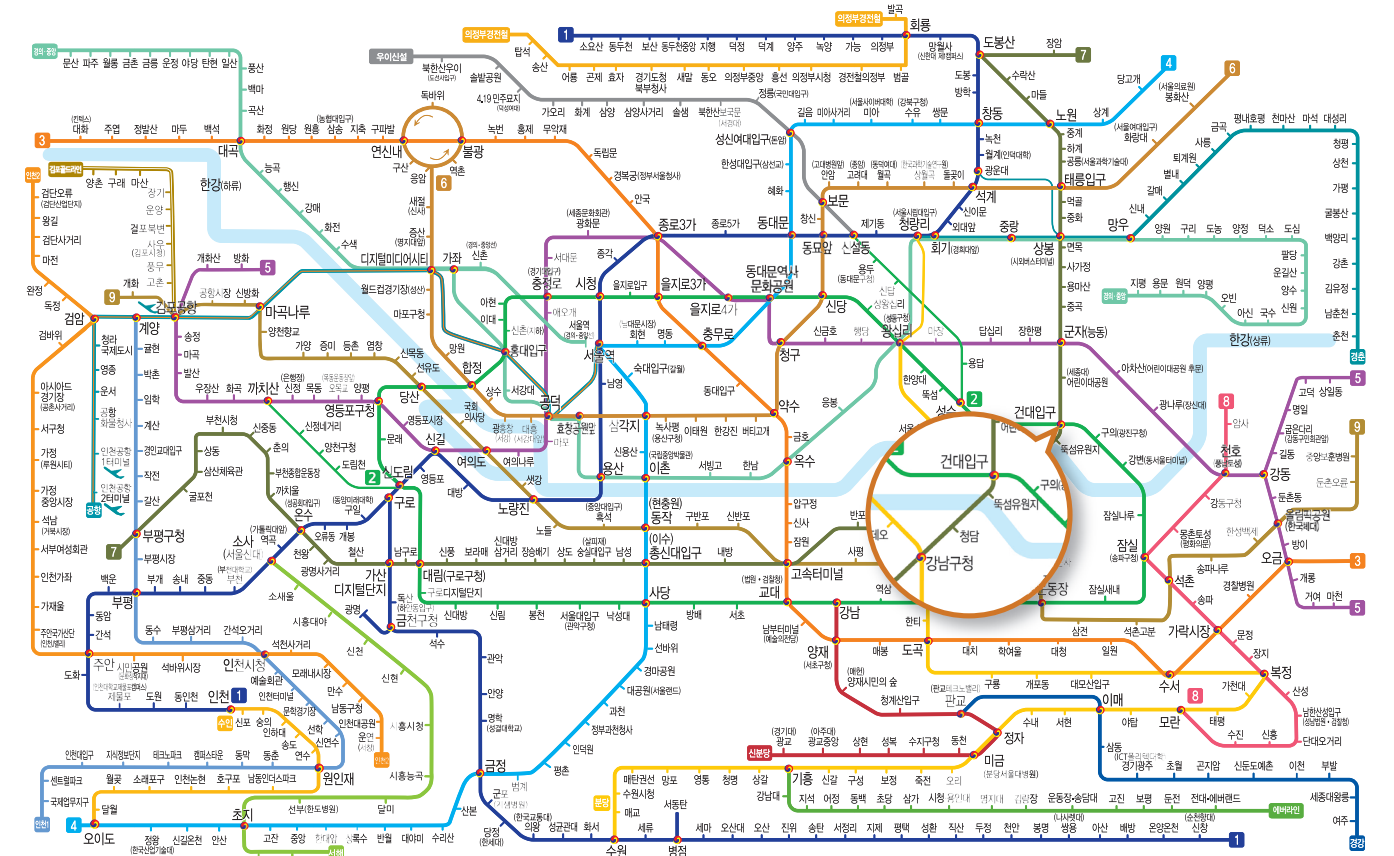
